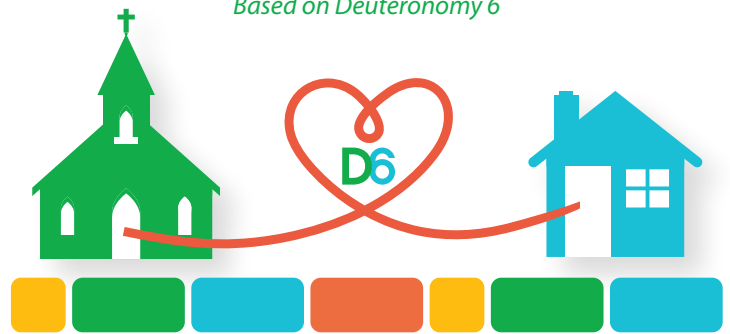

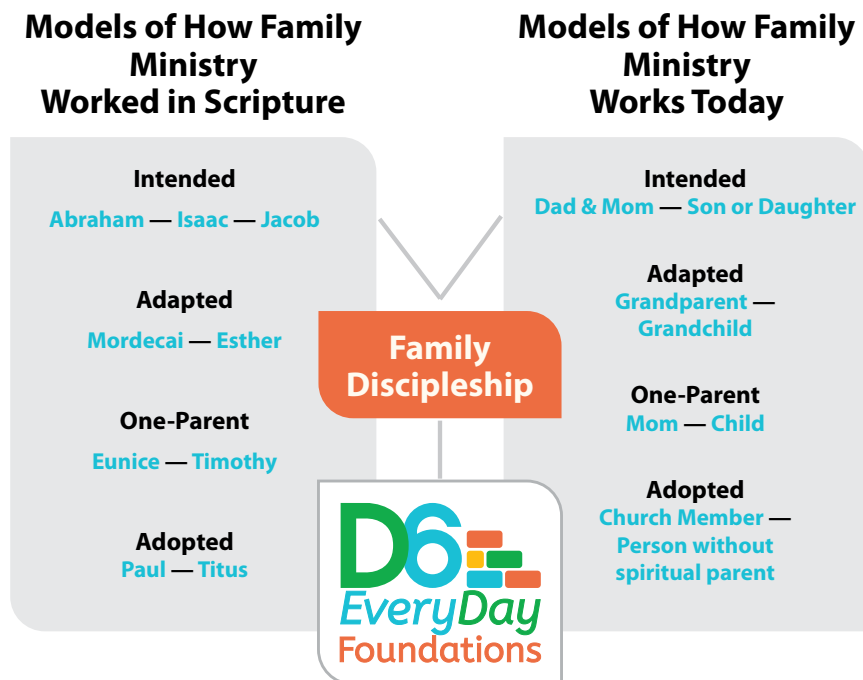

Family ministry curriculum, from birth to grandparents, *D6 Everyday Foundations* is a family-aligned curriculum that is biblically sound and based on the principles of Deuteronomy 6.

WHAT IS A FAMILY?

The family is not always an ideal set of parents and kids all doing what God intended. The Bible shows adapted models of generational discipleship. The often-quoted and normal succession of teaching flows from father to son and on to grandson as seen in Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. There is not always a godly father or mother as evidenced in Mordecai teaching his cousin Esther or Paul mentoring Titus, his adopted son in the faith (Titus 1:4). Notice how Timothy's faithful mother and grandmother seemed to carry the whole spiritual parental influence. Regardless of your season of life, God can use you to teach someone in your family or sphere of influence by way of friendships and connections.



In a day of eroding morals and shifting values, how do you equip people to stand for Truth? People need a confident knowledge of God's Word and its application for real life. **D6 EveryDay Foundations** curriculum provides biblical exegesis, scriptural principles, and studies of key Old and New Testament characters. This foundation of Christ and the unshakeable Word of God constructs a solid groundwork for one's faith.

But is what happens at church enough? No! Even if the student never misses a single Sunday in the three-year cycle, the task is too much for curriculum alone. We must also depend on the work of the Holy Spirit and the partnership of families so the Truth goes beyond head knowledge to heart knowledge and anchors in a permanent place. Combining both at-church and at-home tools, **D6 EveryDay Foundations** curriculum helps churches equip parents with the mortar to hold together the building blocks of faith.

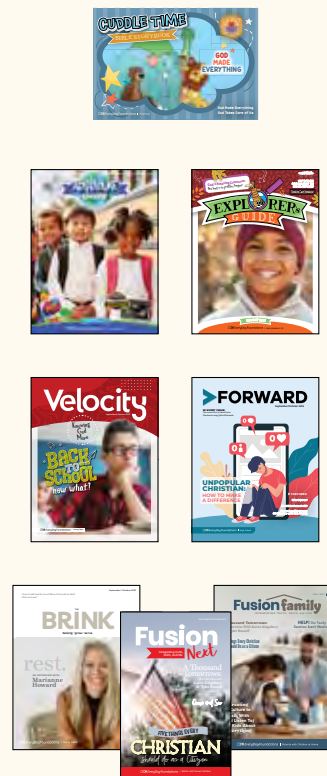

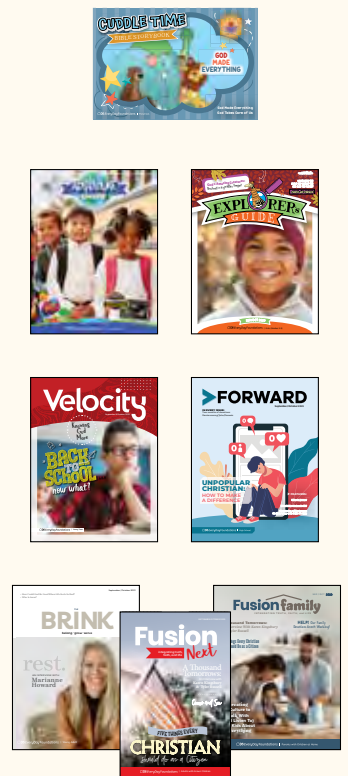

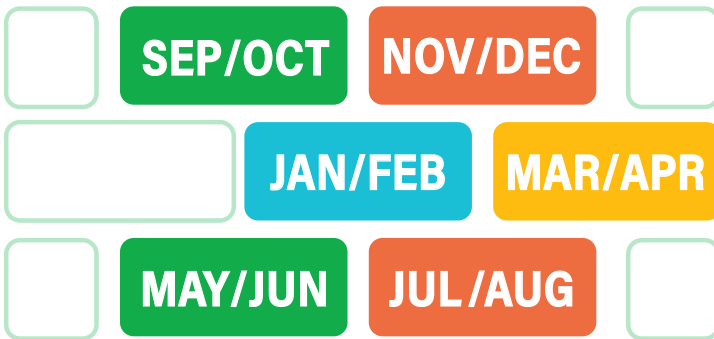

GENERATIONAL DISCIPLESHIP

The **three-year scope and sequence** includes an overview of the Old and New Testaments emphasizing major characters and themes. There are also lessons that emphasize the application of God's Word to current cultural issues. Look for icons next to the date to spot these special lessons.

To meet the needs of preschool learners, lessons use repetition to reinforce learning. Preschool units sometimes align with older ages, but age-appropriate teaching does not allow weekly alignment.



Research and surveys show many churches and groups prefer 4- to 10-week Bible studies over longer studies. **D6 EveryDay Foundations** curriculum is set up in two-month blocks rather than 13-week quarters.

This accommodates:

- More starting points, making it easier for newcomers to join in existing classes and groups
- More times to emphasize and promote discipleship
- More opportunities to grow by starting new groups more often

Family Theme | **Jesus Is God** Date | **September 10, 2023**
Study Text | **John 1:1-18**

Read the Word: John 1:1-18

Disciple Your Family: Learners discuss with family members how we should worship, trust, and obey Jesus because He is fully God and fully man.

Discuss the following Key Truths and how to apply them to life. Use the questions to spark discussion.

- Key Truth: Jesus Was Actively Involved in Creation (John 1:1-3)**
- How do verses 1-3 affirm the divinity of Christ? (He existed before Creation; He was with God; He was active in creating all things, etc.)
 - APPLY:** Worship Christ as God who put on flesh, the very expression of who God is in human form.
 - How do verses 1-3 point to the doctrine of the Trinity—one God in three persons? (Jesus, the Word, was with God the Father but separate from Him; Jesus is God; etc.)
 - APPLY:** We can have confidence in what the Bible says about Creation. We are not the result of random chance. Christ is God and was active in Creation.
 - Our culture is sometimes guilty of trying to change Jesus to fit whatever is trending. Why is it dangerous to let culture and what's popular define who Jesus is?
 - Consider the people you're around on an average day. How do they view Jesus? How can we help people see Jesus for who He truly is?

- Key Truth: Jesus Brought Life and Truth to the Lost World (John 1:4-13)**
- What is meant by light and darkness in verses 4-5? (Light stands for what is good, right, and true. Darkness stands for what is evil, wrong, and false.)
 - What does it mean to walk in the light of God's truth? (We obey and live out God's Word.)
 - APPLY:** Walk daily in the light of God's truth.
 - Live in ways that shine the light and truth of Jesus to the world around us and bear witness about Christ to those who need to hear.
 - What makes you apprehensive about sharing the truth of Jesus with others?
 - In what ways can we shine the light of Christ in the world around us? (Live out the truths and principles of God's Word; tell others about the life we have found in Christ; etc.)
 - When we share the truth of Jesus, many will reject that message. How should we measure success? (See 1 Corinthians 3:6-7)

- Key Truth: Jesus Was God in Human Flesh Living Among Us (John 1:14-18)**
- APPLY:** Jesus understands life in this world because He became one of us and lived among us.
 - APPLY:** God pours out His grace on us through Jesus. We can know God through Jesus who reveals the heart, mind, and nature of God.

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Daily review of the verse of the month and the Building Blocks will help your children plant them in their hearts.

- How has God shown you grace?
- What is a proper response to the grace God has given us through Christ? (Give Him our love, obedience, worship, and service.)
- Evaluate this statement: "Many people want Christ's grace, yet they don't want to obey His truth." Why do grace and truth go hand-in-hand? (Truth shows us who God is and grace makes it possible to be in right relationship with Him; etc.)
- What can we learn about God from the life of Jesus? (He loves us; He is holy and without sin; He is merciful and full of grace; etc.)

Build a Foundation: Elementary talking points for discussion.

- What are four things John 1 teaches us about who Jesus is?
- What is the Trinity? (Read Growing in God's Word in Adventure Guide and Explorer's Guide with your child.)
- What are ways you can thank and worship God for who He is and for His grace this week?

Work together to memorize the Verse of the Month: **John 1:1**

Discuss This Week's Building Block:
Jesus is 100% God, but He is also 100% man. This is called the incarnation.

Everyday Extras:

Play Password or some other word game with your family. (We love "Nouns in a Bucket.") Talk together about the way a word represents a thought. We can communicate because we recognize words and the ideas they stand for. The letters C-A-T are not able to purr, but when we see them, we know what they mean. Jesus was more about God because He was the personification of both God and God's message to us. We understand word without using any words. (Some ideas might be love, kindness, power, savior, etc.) Ask everyone to act out their word without using any words. Could they still get their ideas across? Let's communicate Jesus to everyone who sees us!

Preschool Highlights:

Today your child learned **God Has Many Names** which help us learn about Him. God told Abraham He was the Almighty God. Abraham and his wife, Sarah, were very old. But God told Abraham and Sarah they would have a child, and they were to name him Isaac. The Almighty God is strong and powerful, and nothing is impossible for Him.

Preschool Highlights give the Heartprint (Bible truth) of young children's lessons each week.

Everyday Extras suggest a home activity to connect Bible truth with family life.

Parent Pages review the key truths and applications of each lesson, allowing for family discussion and reinforcements.
